My husband and I are residents of the Orangetree neighborhood in Chandler. Our neighborhood does not have a city park.

There is a water retention basin on the corner of North Bullmoose Drive and West El Alba. I know that I and many residents of our neighborhood would like to see this retention basin turned into a city park.

This retention basin has been poorly maintained for many years. When it rains, it takes a long time to drain and dry out which often results in a large influx of mosquitos. The fence is rusted and sagging in many places, and lots of dead, dry weeds. It is overall an unattractive property which does not adequately do the job it is supposed to do.

Based on information presented at recent neighborhood meetings, the owners of the property, which includes the Cathedral of Praise church building, are unable to maintain the property and have been trying unsuccessfully to sell the land. The retention basin makes the property unattractive to developers since it can not be developed.

I know many Chandler city residents in this area would support and appreciate the city taking ownership of the basin (or even purchasing the entire property) and turning it into a city park that could be enjoyed instead of watching the property further deteriorate. I hope the planning committee will review this property and help end the blight this deteriorating property and poorly functioning water retention basin have been for our neighborhood. While visiting Santa Fe New Mexico, I was able to experience their "single owner dog park". This dog park was different from others in that only one owner could use the dog park at a time, for a maximum of 30 minutes if others were waiting. When I heard about this park I thought "who would want to wait in line to use the park", but I was surprised to find that many people were waiting. I waited 2 hours for my turn, and there were many waiting after me. This park has been the only dog park we have been able to enjoy.

You see, I own a service dog, an animal that I rely on for my medical health, who has had thousands of dollars of invested in her training and purchase. Often, public dog parks are visited by dog owners who don't clean up after their dog, something that could pose a health risk to dogs if they are not properly vaccinated. There are other owners who don't stop or remove their dog when it chases scared dogs, or when their dog demonstrates overly dominant behavior. All of this put my service animal at risk of not being able to do her job, thus it is not safe for me to visit public dog parks.

I ask that as you expand the number of parks you consider the "single owner dog park" model used in Santa Fe so dogs who are too fearful, too aggressive, or have a job to do can enjoy the freedom of running in a large open and secure space.

I am a resident of the Orangetree Subdivision, a traditional neighborhood located in the City of Chandler. The water retention basin that services my subdivision is located on the corner of North Bullmoose Drive and West El Alba Way. I'm writing regarding the possibility of turning the water retention basin into a small city park.

Although the land on which this retention easement is privately owned, it is my understanding that the City of Chandler is still responsible for ensuring the maintenance of the easement land. The City has been failing in this duty.

Every time it rains, it takes an exceptionally long time for the basin to dry out, with a lot of little puddles remaining around the grates that are currently choked with weeds and debris, so our neighborhood is exposed to a large influx of mosquitoes.

The basin is surrounded by a fence that is in poor condition, rusted and sagging. There are an abundance of weeds that dry out in the summer and the trees are not properly cared for or trimmed. There are a lot of dead, dry branches on the ground and dead dry trees. This presents an impending fire hazard to the neighborhood.

This plot of land is on a high traffic street and is very visible to everyone that lives in our neighborhood and people driving past on Warner Road. It makes this portion of Chandler look like a derelict neighborhood, despite city efforts to upgrade our walls and clean up the roadsides. The entire Cathedral of Praise property is an abandoned eyesore and health hazard. The owners are reportedly elderly, and no longer able to afford reasonable maintenance.

The owner has been trying to sell the land, but developers aren't interested when the albatross of the basin is subtracted from the value of the property. In addition, residents are rightfully resistant to the idea of high density housing parked on this heavily traveled, highly visible street and would much prefer an open park in this section of the neighborhood.

It would serve the City residents of this area extremely well if Chandler could take over ownership of the basin, or even purchase the entire "Cathedral of Praise" lot and turn it into a city park. I hope the planning committee will review this property and help end the blight our neighborhood has suffered for the last fifteen years that the basin and church has been so poorly maintained. Hello, we are longtime Chandler residents who live near the retention basin off of Bullmoose Rd., south of Warner. I am writing to request that the City of Chandler consider legally obtaining this basin to properly maintain it and add a much-needed community park to the only square mile in Chandler without one.

The retention basin on Bullmoose is currently owned, and poorly-managed and maintained, by the Cathedral of Praise Church on Warner and Bullmoose. How the church acquired legal rights to the basin is a mystery to us all, especially when rainwater from the entire neighborhood feeds into it. How is this legally possible, especially when the church really has no incentive nor motivation to maintain it. They are not the ones who suffer every time it rains, but the rest of the neighborhood does!

The basin has been improperly maintained for decades. After a particularly heavy rainfall a few years ago, because the basin was not draining properly, it filled to capacity and overflowed, flooding the surrounding neighborhood streets. Multiple cars became stranded, as drivers attempted to navigate through the flooded streets to their homes, and some of these cars' electrical systems shorted out. The water sat there for days, until the fire department came and pumped it out. After most other storms, the water sits in the basin until it evaporates, inviting mosquitoes. This is unacceptable!

The Cathedral of Praise Church recently tried to sell the entire property to a developer who was met with resistance from the neighborhood when we all realized the developer wanted to cram 57 homes onto the 5 acre section to the south of the basin, using the 7 acres within the basin as part of the math to make that legally happen (making it appear there were 4.75 houses per acre instead of the actual number of 11.4 per acre). The developer eventually backed out of the project. However, we know the Church is currently motivated to sell. This would be an opportune moment for the city to approach the owners to legally acquire this land and do what needed to be done to begin with in regards to the retention basin.

The neighborhood surrounding the retention basin is family-oriented. We currently have to drive to other neighborhoods to find a place for our children to play. The retention basin would serve as an excellent soccer field, if it can be properly maintained so it will immediately drain after rain and won't have standing water. The higher grounds to the south of the basin would make the perfect location for a playground. It would also benefit the neighborhood a great deal to have a public pool at the southern end of the property, if this is at all possible.

We hope you will take a serious look at this part of the city and will do what has needed to be done for a long, long time. The neighbors are tired of the eyesore and the swamp, and would love something beautiful and inviting in its place. A place where families can enjoy flying a kite, or a picnic, kicking a ball, playing on slides and swings, and

getting some fresh air. Please, please PLEASE acquire this property and build a proper retention basin and park for our community.

I am the President of Desert Rivers Audubon, the Audubon chapter in the SE Valley. We lead birdwalks at Veterans Oasis Park on a monthly basis from Nov through Apr. I think the parks resources have been mismanaged. You should know that birding tourism whether for local residents or people coming from around the state of around the country is a multi-billion-dollar industry. VO could be a great place to see birds, unfortunately because of how the ponds are managed, it is not as good as it could be. The water level did not change from the permanent water area in some of the ponds for so long that the vegetation has grown so thick around that permanent water area and you can't see into the ponds. As a birdwalk leader, you can't show people birds on the water if you can't see the water. Additionally, these are recharge ponds, they are supposed to be filled and then allowed to drain and recharge the aquifer. By doing that and having some ponds be full while other ponds are drying out and some dry, you create a wide variety of habitats for birds from deeper water to shallow water to mud flats to drier banks. This in turns attracts a variety of bird species and attracts a large number of birders to look at them who spend money at local businesses. They have mismanaged the ponds for so long that they need to go in and remove the reeds, till up the basins so that the water can drain correctly, cut and keep clear viewing areas. We are willing to donate some shade trees if there are some improvements. If changes aren't forthcoming, we will start a letter writing campaign and make our complaints to the city council. We won't have much choice but to stop doing our programming at the park.

I am also a daily user of Sunset Park on Terrace and Ray Rds. I am appalled that you have an African Sumac tree planted there. This is a horribly invasive tree. I live across the street from this park and it is a constant battle to keep this out of my landscape. My neighbor gave up and now has a huge tree in her yard.
