PUBLIC NOTICE

The City of Chandler will hold a Special Election on May 18, 2010. Proposition 300 is a measure that will appear on the election ballot. Proposition 300 is being referred to the voters by the Chandler City Council and asks for a one-time override of the state-imposed expenditure limitation.

The Chandler City Clerk will accept arguments supporting or opposing Proposition 300 until 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, February 17, 2010. The City Clerk's office is located at 55 N. Arizona Place, Suite 203, Chandler, Arizona.

Each argument cannot exceed 200 words in length and must contain the original, notarized signature of each person sponsoring it. If the argument is sponsored by an organization, it shall contain the notarized signature of two executive officers of the organization or if sponsored by a political committee it shall contain the notarized signature of the committee's chairman or treasurer. The person or persons signing the argument shall identify themselves by giving an address and telephone number, which information shall not appear in the publicity pamphlet.

Arguments will be printed in the election publicity pamphlet that is mailed to each household containing a registered voter prior to the start of early voting.
