

RESOLUTION NO. 4354

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHANDLER, ARIZONA, PROPOSING A ONE-TIME OVERRIDE OF THE STATE-IMPOSED EXPENDITURE LIMITATION AND SETTING A SPECIAL ELECTION FOR MAY 18, 2010.

WHEREAS, the Arizona State Constitution permits the submission to the voters of a city or town of a one-time override to the City's expenditure limitation under Article IX, Section 20(2)(c); and

WHEREAS, the Chandler voters in 1982, 1986, 1990, 1994, 1998, 2002 and again in 2006 have authorized the local alternative expenditure limitation; and

WHEREAS, the City's current local alternative expenditure limitation (Home Rule Option) expires at the end of FY 2009-10, therefore a one-time override must be presented to the voters for FY 2010-11.

WHEREAS, the Chandler City Council, after two public hearings, has determined that a one-time override of the state-imposed expenditure limitation is necessary for the City of Chandler.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Chandler City Council:

SECTION 1. That the City Clerk is authorized to enter into an agreement with the Maricopa County Election Department for the administration of the election.

SECTION 2. That the following one-time override of the state-imposed expenditure limitation be submitted to the qualified Chandler voters at a Special Election to be held May 18, 2010:


Shall the City of Chandler exceed the state-imposed expenditure limitation for Fiscal Year 2010-11 by \$49,000,000, to allow the City to adopt a budget no greater than the amount that was adopted for Fiscal Year 2009-10?



NOW, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Chandler City Council:

"The Chandler City Council shall, as part of the 2010-11 Budget adopt an expenditure limitation to govern the City of Chandler budget for the fiscal year immediately following such adoption. The expenditure limitation shall be adopted after a Public Hearing at which the citizens may comment on the proposed expenditure limitation. No expenditure may be made in violation of such Budget, nor may any proposed expenditures be in excess of estimated available revenues except that the City Council may, by three-fourths vote, declare an emergency and suspend the effect for one fiscal year at a time."
