- Represent City of Chandler at the Arizona League of Cities and Towns' Conference and at Youth Leadership Day at the Arizona State Capitol





Applicants must submit an application, a letter of recommendation, and attend three consecutive meetings to be recommended for appointment by the Chandler Mayor & City Council.
