Student of the Year

This award is to recognize a student with a disability who has excelled beyond his or her apparent limitations.

Criteria:

- Student must be a resident of Chandler (at least one year).
- Nominee has displayed the courage to learn and grow to his or her fullest potential.
- Student must be between the ages of 3 and 22.
- Nominee has demonstrated the willingness to pursue and achieve personal goals despite his or her disability.

Volunteer of the Year

This award recognizes an individual who has demonstrated consistent and outstanding volunteer service to people with disabilities.

Criteria:

- Nominee has contributed a needed service in the community of Chandler in 2017.
- Involvement of the nominee was in an active role, not as a figurehead.
- Amount of time devoted to the activity or service was significant.
- The activity or service provided produced positive changes for individuals with disabilities.

Habilitator/Educator of the Year

This award recognizes an individual who has worked in the field of training or educating people with disabilities.

Criteria:

- Nominee has worked in the field of educating or habilitating people with disabilities in Chandler during 2017.
- Involvement of the nominee was in an active role, not as a figurehead.
- The work as an educator or habilitator produced positive changes for individuals with disabilities.
