



Residential Solar Incentives



Solar Electric

- Arizona State Tax Credit – 25% of installation cost, up to \$1,000
- Federal Tax Credit – 30% of installation cost
- Utility Incentives –APS reimburses \$3.00 per watt and SRP reimburse \$2.70 per watt (up to \$13,500). Beginning May 1, 2010, SRP incentives will be \$2.55 per watt.

Solar Water Heater

- Arizona State Tax Credit – 25% of installation cost, up to \$1,000
- Federal Tax Credit – 30% of installation cost, up to \$2,000
- Utility Incentives
 - APS - \$0.75 per kWh savings in first year
 - SRP - \$0.50 per kWh savings
