

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

ABOUT THE FIREFIGHTER OPEN REGISTRATION EVENTS

ON APRIL 18-20, 2010

1. How and when do I pick up an application to enter your recruitment process?

You will need to attend only one of the open registration days to register for the written test, thus entering the recruitment process. You will not be picking up or turning in an application at that time but submitting the **REGISTRATION FORM** instead. Registration dates and times are as follows:

- **April 18 – 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.**

2. How do I get my test date?

To be eligible to take the written test, you must attend the open registration on one of the designated days only. You may not request a registration card by phone, email or mail. At that time, you will complete and turn in your registration card. Remember, only the first 670 registration forms received each day will be able to take the written test.

At the time of registration, you will receive your written test date.

3. When do I provide proof of your minimum requirements?

At the time of check in at the written test, you must provide proof of all of the following:

- Be eighteen (18) years of age or older
- Have a high school diploma or equivalent GED
- Show a current/valid Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) certificate for the State of Arizona or National Registry, or proof of current enrollment in an EMT class
- Valid Driver's License

4. How do I find out if I passed the test?
