

NON-RESIDENT FEE POLICY

The City of Chandler Community Services Department is committed to offering residents a wide range of services and activities at the lowest overall cost. Due to increased fiscal demands for new and expanded services, it has become increasingly difficult to maintain existing levels of service for residents. A new non-resident fee policy has been implemented by the Parks & Recreation Board that is intended to apportion to non-residents an equalized fee so that they contribute to the funding of aquatics, parks and recreation programs, facilities and services on an equitable basis with residents that pay City taxes.

Effective with the fall 2009 registration period, which began Saturday, August 8, all classes, activities, programs and rentals outlined in the Break Time and other related services provided by the Community Services Department have a non-resident fee that applies to all participants who don't reside within Chandler's City limits. The non-resident fee represents a 25% increase above the resident rate and is rounded up to the next dollar.

Residency for all new customers will need to be verified by staff using one of the following: picture ID with local address, current (within last month) water or utility bill, voter registration card, hunting/fishing license, current vehicle registration or business license and check imprinted with a Chandler address.
