## VETERANS OASIS PARK IS A GREAT LOCATION FOR A PICNIC, COOKOUT OR BIRTHDAY PARTY?



All park ramadas are close to the Urban Fishing Lake and include accessible facilities and barbeque grills. The cost to reserve a ramada is \$3 per hour for residents and \$4 per hour for non-residents. To find out more or to make

### Ramada Use Rules:

- Ramadas are available on a first-come, first-served basis unless already reserved.
- Reservations must be made in advance at the Environmental Education Center.
- No moon bounces, jumpers, or amplified sound allowed.
- Bicycle, skateboard and rollerblade use is not permitted in the ramadas.
- Glass containers are prohibited.
- A malt beverage permit is required for alcohol use in the park.

### EXPERIENCE THE HERITAGE OF DESERT FARMING AT TUMBLEWEED RANCH.

The Ranch features animals, farm equipment and historic houses from Chandler's agricultural past. Explore the Ranch and the McCroskey House every second Saturday throughout the winter.

Built in 1917, the McCroskey House was restored to look as it did in the 1920s. Located south of Tumbleweed Recreation Center, on Pioneer Parkway, at McQueen and Germann Roads.

Join us from Noon-4 p.m. every second Saturday for self-guided house tours, garden walks, and family activities, all free of charge.
