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# CALIFORNIA VACATION DETAILS




## The Cities of Chandler and Mesa present a CALIFORNIA VACATION ADVENTURE

Saturday night will conclude with a San Diego Padres baseball game at PETCO Park. Participants are responsible for lunch on Friday and Saturday and dinner on Friday. Saturday's breakfast and dinner, "Dine with Shamu", is included in the price of the trip. Participants will also need spending money.

You must be a participant in the City of Chandler or City of Mesa programs to attend this trip. There are 20 spaces for Chandler program participants and 20 for Mesa. Once the 40 slots are filled, a waiting list will be kept for possible vacancies. A participant information packet will be sent once the initial registration form is processed.
