What is the General Plan?

The General Plan is a *policy* document developed to guide the future of the city. The purpose of a general plan is to outline actionable goals and policies that guide future growth and physical development in a way that support the community's vision and values.

Why is it Important?

The general plan was last revised in 2016, since then Chandler has experienced many changes and opportunities. Updating the general plan is essential for the city to remain relevant and responsive to the community's vision and values. This update will ensure the city is appropriately assessing and responding to these changes while considering growth opportunities and supporting the built environment that the community wants to see.

When does the Process Start?

The planning process will take approximately **17 months** allowing enough time to evaluate, collaborate, and create a general plan that truly reflects the vision and priorities of the community. After City Council adoption of the general plan update, it will need to be approved by the voters of Chandler in August 2026.

What does a General Plan include?

- A vision statement.
- Future land use and circulation maps.
- Goals and policies related to topic areas.
- Action items systematically implementing the community's vision.

What's NOT in the General Plan?

- Tax increases
- Regulations or changes to property zoning
- Building codes/permits

Will the General Plan Update change the zoning of my property? No, the General Plan Update will not change the zoning of your property.



Will the General Plan Update result in an increase in taxes?

No, the General Plan Update will not result in an increase in taxes.

Will the General Plan be updated again in the future?



Yes, the General Plan is a "living" document, meaning it will continue to change as the city changes and grows. There will be opportunities to provide feedback in the future as well.
